Bathtub re-ensemeling

Method statement provided by MILTON'S BATH ENAMEL REPAIR

We would first strip off the old coating before applying the new one. This requires some additional time and materials compared to a standard bath resurfacing.

After that we remove any grime and dirt off the bath through sanding and the application of some chemicals to thoroughly clean the existing surface so there is nothing between our new surface and the old one.

We then apply a bonding agent which allows our coating to stick to your bath.

Then we apply another bonding agent that is sprayed on which is a type of primer.

Once this is cured we then re spray the entire bath with 3-4 coats of enamel.

And finally, we apply infrared lamps to start the curing process (hardening of the surface).

We use the best equipment and have machines to extract unwanted fumes from the room, we also use the best materials for the bath which we source from various places.

Our technicians are thoroughly trained and we pass down 30 years of experience in bath resurfacing.

The repair comes with 5 years warranty for flaking and cracking, by experience our work lasts for at least 10 – 15 years.
