- Use and apply well thought through approaches to our work in Camden for example using data, trend analysis and evidence to support professional thinking, provide critical challenge within the organisation and to inform continuous improvement.
- Design, facilitate and run workshops being comfortable to deliver in a face-to-face environment as well as online, and be able to deal with the unexpected and emotionally complex.
- Balance working at pace and managing multiple priorities, being flexible and adaptable to meet the needs of the business and be flexible and adaptable.
