Hi Planners

With regard to the proposed tree felling at 29 Priory Terrace - I live at 34 Priory Road which is directly opposite 29 Priory Terrace.

I am very concerned about the proposed felling of the 4 trees in our conservation area. With all the very real concern about climate change I believed the perceived view is that it is very necessary to keep and plant as many trees as possible not chop them down.

It is my belief that the owners of 29 Priory Terrace have built a balcony on the raised ground floor as a prequel to possibly dividing the house and selling half in order to pay for the enormous expense they must have incurred because they have had builders for at least 4 months.

If these trees are felled it will give whoever moves into 29 Priory Terrace a direct view into my kitchen and my balcony - furthermore I cannot see the advantage of felling these trees as they are at the bottom of their garden and will also give whoever moves there privacy from me and the other occupants of 34 Priory Road at flats C and D.

I feel that it is criminal to fell these trees in the current climate and it would be far better just to prune the trees - especially as the builders have already removed lots of branches from these trees. I feel it would be so much better for whoever moves there to look at trees in leaf rather than at a bare fence which will be the case if the trees are felled.

I can see no advantage to anyone to fell these trees which also provide food and safety to generations of squirrels and birds that have also lived there for years and do not detract light from anyone.
