Dear Mr Greenhalgh

I write to support the above application. It will help to support the existence and future of the synagogue communities which extend into Camden. Among its many positive effects the Eruv will enable members of families with young children to bring them to the synagogues on the Sabbath using buggies, enabling all members of the family to become more active within the communities. This will particularly affect mothers, who are generally the carers who choose to remain at home with the young children, because without the existence of an Eruv they are not permitted to use a buggy on the Sabbath.

The same considerations apply to wheelchair owners.

An Eruv has already been approved in many parts of London with no real visible effects. The placing of the necessary poles and wires has been carefully planned and it has been found in other areas that they are unexceptional and soon merge into the generality of existing street furniture.
