T17 - Sycamore (Neighbours Tree at No.17); Cut back overhanging branches back to boundary taking to suitable growth points or main stem where appropriate. Crown lift to 6m and crown thin by approximately 15%.	
Reason for works - Routine cyclical maintenance of trees in order to retain size and shape of crowns following historic crown reductions and to prevent suckering stems and ivy from establishing and causing future issue.
