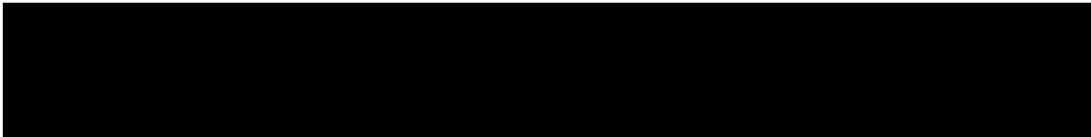

Hello,
The above planning variation has come to my attention.
My business Bar Polski T/A Na Zdrowie the Polish Bar , 11 Little Turnstile and the business Little Venice cafe 7-8 Little Turnstile, owned by Mr Enver Aliu will be adversely affected by this variation.
We were not consulted and the impact on our business was not considered when deciding to build a bin storage directly in front of our businesses. We are food and beverage retailers and refuse located so close to our front doors is not acceptable.
I believe this breaches planning policy especially section 106 and we intend to make our representations and take our complaint to all executives in the LB Camden and if necessary to Mr Micheal Gove, Secretary of state for housing, communities and local government.
The original planning application was an improvement to the area, the alteration is not.
Please confirm that the Bloomsbury Conservation Advisory Committee have been informed of the change to the original planning application.
I will write further re this issue, in the meantime please inform the developers that we intend to vehemently object to this change so that they do not proceed in erecting the bin storage.
