The Council confirms that the remedial works as described above are exempt from the need for further notifications or any formal application to the Council and you are therefore allowed to proceed.

- 1 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
- Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife. Conditions and Reasons:

Prior to the end of March 2022, a Ulmus "New Horizon" (New Horizon elm) shall be planted in the front garden of the property in accordance with the Tree Location Plan drawing by Kin Land Design ref. 2_MARSFD_GNS_L888 dated 22/10/2021 unless otherwise agreed with the council in writing. The tree shall have a stem circumference of 18-20cm at 1m above the rootball at the time of planting and shall be planted and maintained in accordance with BS8545:2014. Should the tree die or become seriously diseased within 5 years of planting its shall be replaced with a tree of the same specification detailed in this condition.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 206 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).
