Due to the heavy traffic and resulting pollution, trees are of considerable environmental benefit in this area and should only be removed as the very last resort. It appears that the removal of these trees is being proposed on a precautionary basis. The cracking was only discovered in July 2021 and the structural damage is said to be ¿very slight¿. Level monitoring should be carried out to establish whether there is in fact an ongoing problem and, if so, the extent of it. It is not clear that the drainage problems have been fully investigated and resolved and it is possible that these may be the cause of the damage.
