We have seen the application to prune two large trees a lime and a copper beech, both subject to a TPO on the site of 22 Frognal (application registered 25 November 2021 (but without any time after 24 November 2021 allowed for comment). We write to express concerns about the possible effects of the proposed extensive 2m pruning of the magnificent copper beech. This was already a mature tree in 1971 when we moved to this address, The aerial plan attached to the application does not show the surrounding area. This tree is visible from many directions including Church Row and the churchyard and is one of the glories of the conservation area, It stands facing our house and garden and forms an important screen for both properties,
