I feel that there should be no objection to single storey ground floor rear extensions in Lawn Road. The design of the houses and the relatively big gardens mean that these can be added without causing any issues to the Conservation Area or to neighbours. (I would emphasise that this only applies to single storey extensions, double height extensions are completely unacceptable because of the impact they have on neighbours' light

and overlooking issues.)
