Dear Tree officers and planners,

May I wish you the Seasons Greetings and a Happy and Healthy 2022. In a previous email, I said that I was standing down from the DPNF, but have decided to stay on the Committee, so am representing them and the DPCAAC too.

List 663 2021/5990/T 2021/5991/T 2021/5992/T The first two of these applications relate to No 30 Bramshill Gardens (see amended address; was 32). The third one relates to the communal garden at the rear of the listed Pentad at Nos 22 - 32 Winscombe Sreet, N19. Sharon Hosegood Associates (SHA) have prepared a S211 notice;

SHA 1422, dated December 2021. This includes a current survey and proposed works to be carried out in Winscome Street and Bramshill Gardens in order to improve and maintain the gardens for the foreseeable future. Currently a wall has been removed adjacent to the HNCC development site, this will be replaced and espalier fruit trees, together with a birch grove in front of it, have been proposed, presumably to 'soften' the effect of the new bare wall.

I visited the site on December 13th and have been shown all of the relevant trees. I do not object to the proposed tree works being carried out, many are much needed, some trees need to be removed due to poor condition. However, you may decide not to fell the the six Ash saplings (G6) as they have been pollarded in the past, but poorly. I do not object to the work on the TPO'd Lime (T11)(C862 2009). I welcome the new proposed planting, but regular maintenance will have to be carried out in the future to maintain and develop the improved and updated communal garden.
