My flat overlooks the new wooden structure that is the subject of this planning application, and my flat is closest to 71–75 Shelton Street, and is closest flat to their upper terrace. My neighbour, from number 13 is drafting this for me as English is not my first language. Should you wish to contact me personally, my email address is on the form. I would like to object to this planning application. I have already had to endure several very noisy party's at 71-75 Shelton Street. No regard for the residents of our block was given regarding the noise levels emanating from the already built structure on these occasions. On the first occasion, on the higher terrace, very loud music blared out of the open plan rooftop for 3 nights up to 2:00am. There are other examples that the current operator is not trustworthy regarding any assurances they might give regarding noise, as after the three night upper terrace noise pollution event, other loud events have happened in the already build wooden structure on the lower terrace. I would worry that further disturbances would become commonplace. My neighbour has documented these events and sent them to a Sophie Bowden. Her email address is Sophie.Bowden@camden.gov.uk In my view and current experience, the wooden construction materials are totally inappropriate for noise absorption and I would worry that the escaping noise would affect the quite enjoyment of my home. This would be particularly apparent during the milder months when my windows are open. I would also like to object on the grounds that this planning application would change the nature of Garden Studios, going from an office use to one of entertainment, with all the inconsiderations regarding noise and general activity that this type of venue generates. Should this application be granted, will it not also open the way for other landlords to apply for such licenses in the vicinity?
