2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF DEVELOPMENT	Install 2 x stainless steel wire mesh systems to the side of 2 housing block walls on Compton Close and Stanhope Street. The housing blocks are Hawkshead and Compton Close. The purpose of this is to offer street level greening on roads which are frequently used as main routes for HS2 construction vehicles. The additional greening will also go someway to help mitigate against the loss of 2 hectares of public open space in the area. Plants being proposed have specific properties to help improve air quality. Evergreen climbers will be planted on the wire mesh systems and low level planting.
	Ongoing maintenance of the living walls and planters will be completed by LBC term contractor for grounds maintenance. Idverde.
