The current planning application covers half of these trees.</li> <li>∩ The trees involved are T5 to T8 on the attached map to the west side of the property.</li> <li>∩ T6 has an old decaying wound at 2 metres. The decay extends into the live stem which is unbalanced towards the road. Because of these defects it has been recommended that this tree be pollarded to 3 metres</li> <li>∩ T7 has Kretzschmaria deusta fruiting body present (see close-up photograph in supporting documentation) on the roadside at the base of the tree. The tree forks into two stems at 2 metres. There is a bark included junction between the two stems and decay from an old wound at the same point. One stem grows at 45 degrees over the road. T7 should be felled as a high priority within the next 3 months to avoid spreading the Kretzschmaria deusta to the closely planted adjacent lime trees.</li> <li>∩ Finally trees numbers T5 and T8 to be reduced by 3 ∩ 5 metres to enhance stability given increasing incidents of high wind speeds due to climate change.</li> </ul>
