The materials proposed are not sympathetic to the conservation area nor the environment The size/siting of the room does not appear to provide adequate space for movement of wildlife There is no concession to the environment through for example, rain water collection, sustainable drainage, sedum roof, wood (rather than UPVC) frame, non invasive foundation system Other outbuildings in the conservation area have typically been rendered in wood rather than the material of the main building thus the design is not suitable for a garden room in the conservation area. The application form notes no loss of residential garden land which cannot be accurate The building will sit very high against the boundary walls to both side - more than double height of the boundary wall CRASH asks that Camden assess the application against its own policy guidance and seeks major amendments in the materials and design of this application
