34 Netherhall Gardens has 8 lime trees in the communal front garden. The current planning application covers half of these trees which **we fully support**.

As Public safety must be the priority; Considering the height of those trees, the decaying wounds to few of them and decease on some, it is clear that these works must be undertaken to ensure public safety.

I should also point out that the height of Council (public) trees at half the height of these trees!!! This works will bring those private trees to a height that is more in line with the public trees on the other side of the road, which have been cut much shorter. This would be more safe, sensible, and more harmonious.

We hope that the Council will ensure that ALL trees are reduced to the height of the public trees as soon as possible.
