The proposed compensation planting is:						
T1 to be replaced like-for-like, 1 tree of similar size and species. T14, T18, T19, T21, T24 to be replaced with a heavy standard nursery grown tree of a suitable family, such as a Rowan, Whitebeam, Downy birch or Hornbeam. 5 in total.						
In addition to the above tree removals, trial pits will be dug as part of an investigation into the structural failure of the wall. The locations of these are to be confirmed, but excavation within tree RPAs will be avoided wherever possible. Any trial pits required within the RPAs of retained trees will be carried out using hand tools only, under continuous arboricultural supervision. Due to the Conservation Area covering all trees with DBH >75mm, no damage will be done to any part of these trees. Should any accidental damage occur or be suspected to have occurred, the arboricultural supervisor will halt works and inform the council immediately.
