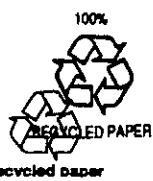
1 I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to refer to the applications made by The Honourable Society of Gray's Inn dated 22 May 1991 for planning permission to change the use of three premises at 9 Gray's Inn Square (third floor) from barristers' chambers to residential at 2 Gray's Inn Square (ground floor south) from residential to barristers' chambers and at 14 Gray's Inn Square (ground floor north) from residential to barristers' chambers. The applications were referred to the Secretary of State for decision pursuant a direction under section 77 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990

2 An officer of the Department has visited the site and has considered the written representations made in support of the applications and those of the London Borough of Camden. A copy of his report is annexed to this letter

3 The London Borough of Camden has no objections to any of the applications. The Officer took the view that in planning terms the applications if approved would maintain the desired balance between chambers/residential use in Gray's Inn. He also noted that none of the applications include works which would affect the external appearance of any of the buildings

4 The Secretary of State has considered the written representations made by the parties and the officer's site visit report. He agrees with the officer's appraisal and conclusions. Therefore, for the reasons given by the officer he hereby grants permission for the respective changes of use from barristers' chambers to residential at 9 Gray's Inn Square (third floor) from residential to barristers' chambers at 2 Gray's Inn Square (ground floor south) and from residential to barristers' chambers at 14 Gray's Inn Square (ground floor north) Gray's Inn London WC1 in accordance with the applications dated 22 May 1991

5 The development hereby permitted shall be begun not later than five years from the date of this letter



6 This letter does not convey any approval or consent which may be required under any enactment byelaws order or regulation other than section 57 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990
