				 On behalf of the BCAAC I object to the proposed rearrangement and replacement of the windows to the relevation. At the moment the rather haphazard arrangement reflects the history of the Victorian building a characteristic of the type. Also the variety of the patterns of the glazing bars, particularly for the closet wing extension, is historically correct while the 8 over 8 and 6 over 6 sash windows are too fussy. We also question the detailed constroint of the proposed windows (are they double glazed? do they have proper timber mullions and individual part of glass?). Furthermore, we regret the loss of the rather fine fenestration of the shop front down the passage and the insertion of a door of inappropriate style. Finally, we doubt that the reformed openings and arches above the windows would be built to anything life standards of the originals.
