including laying of timber decked area.

Objection Yes

Observations The Camden Town CAAC strongly objects to these

proposals which will negatively impact the boundary of the Conservation Area, reducing the outlook and residential amenity of a number of properties on Parkway. A fence as tall as this prevents longer views along gardens which, in this dense backland site, is considered important. The garden on the other side of this taller fence is being used as a children's nursery at present (46-50 Parkway) and is already bounded by tall brick walls on two sides - the lack of air and light that the taller fence will contribute to is

considered detrimental.

Of particular importance are the two mature trees in close vicinity which contribute significantly to the CA and are visible from the public realm in several locations (including Parkway and Albert Street) providing a sense of scale to the diminutive buildings on Parkway. The Committee is concerned that the provision of decking, and professional cooking facilities under the canopy will impact on their health and vitality. All such facilities should be located adjacent to the rear facade of the house and not at the end of the garden to ensure such impacts do not occur.
