2022/0374/PVL	Linus Rees	07/02/2022 19:01:21	OBJ	<p>2022/0374/PVL - Six by Nico, 41 Charlotte Street, London, W1T 1RX (also listed as Six by Nico 33-41 Charlotte Street London W1T 1RU)</p> <p>Our association strongly objects to this application for tables and chairs to be placed in the carriageway.</p> <p>This premises at 41 Charlotte is applying for 12 Tables and 24 Chairs Monday-Saturday 10:00-23:00 Sunday 12:00-22:00.</p> <p>Outside eating and drinking at licensed premises is often a cause of concern for residents living nearby due to the inevitable noise nuisance from customers after consuming alcohol.</p> <p>Fitzrovia is a mixed-use area with commercial premises happily co-existing with people's homes. The neighbourhood is busy during the daytime on weekdays but usually relatively quiet in the evenings and weekends depending on the number of licensed premises in any one street. This is part of the historical character of the area where there is a large daytime working population.</p> <p>However, this balance of uses has recently been upset with the advent of increased outdoor dining that has been fast-tracked by both Camden and Westminster councils and not subject to the usual consultation and scrutiny of licensing applications.</p> <p>Despite Charlotte Street being known for restaurants it has a large residential population. On the east side of the street between Percy Street and Goodge Street there are 39 homes, mostly occupying the upper floors.</p> <p>We are particularly concerned that the terminal hours for outside seating is 23.00 Monday to Saturday, and 22.00 on Sunday. This is very late, especially for seating up to 24 people.</p> <p>For the above reasons the application should be refused.</p>
