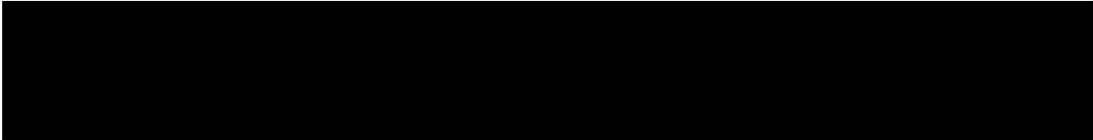

Dear Sir/Madam

I wish to object to the proposed development at the above site.

The scale of the development and the height of the proposed towers will have a detrimental effect on the skyline and on the unique character of the Heath. The building of 825 homes for 2,000 residents will badly impact upon the local area; Gordon House Road is already always gridlocked with traffic and the pavements are extremely narrow by Gospel Oak Station; the infrastructure is just not there to accommodate an additional 2000 residents and office workers and the proposals do not adequately address this issue. It is also surprising that there has been no indication of the percentage of affordable housing in the proposal.

Hampstead Heath is a unique natural environment in London and promotes both physical and mental health. To have tower blocks overwhelming the skyline by the Lido will only be detrimental to all those who currently enjoy the Heath and its amenities.
