I am writing to lodge my formal opposition to the proposed development of the Murphy's Yard site, application 2021/3225/P. Though I am not opposed to new development, the plans indicate a series of buildings that are totally insensitive to the scale of the surrounding neighbourhood and seriously detrimental to the nearby Heath: blocking much-loved views across London from Parliament Hill, creating shade at the very bottom of the Heath and in particular at the Lido, which is beloved for its sunny south-facing terrace especially by cold water swimmers of all ages during the winter months, and injecting a looming presence over the city's most unique open expanse of protected land.

It would be a huge mistake to allow the developer to proceed with the plans that have been submitted for your review. It is the council's responsibility to guide development in Camden so that the area is enhanced by progress, not degenerated.
