Dear Camden Planning Department

I am writing to object to the above application.

I cannot understand why anyone would want to destroy these two beautiful 150-year-old trees which provide such protection against pollution for the local community.

My son has spent a lot of time at primary school - the local school Christopher Hatton - learning how important trees are. We cycle past these trees every day. Even at 9 years old he is outraged at the idea these trees would be felled when there is an alternative to resolve the issue. As he says it would take another 100 years to grow a tree which would give him and other local children that much protection against pollution.

I understand that the trees are causing problems to the back wall of one of the properties on Doughty Mews. I also understand that engineers and tree specialists could work together and solve that problem without felling a single tree.

It seems to be simply a case of money - and the easiest, cheapest solution is to destroy the trees. I really hope that your department will step in - as a community we need to stop these historic and beautiful trees, enjoyed by so many, from being lost forever.
