Notice of Intent for 2 x trees within the Fitzjohn's Netherhall Conservation Area:

My client wishes to reduce the canopies of one London Plane tree (T3) and one Beech tree (T7) growing within the garden of the subject property. These trees have been reduced in the past and it is proposed to reduce the trees back to their previous reduction points.

Application to undertake works to 1 x TPO Lime tree, T4, (Ref 20H-T116):

My client would like to apply to undertake canopy pruning works to reduce the North canopy of T4 from 7m to 5m, the South canopy from 5.5m to 3.5m and the Western canopy from 7m to 5m. The purpose of the proposed works is to increase clearance and lighting levels within the rear garden and to increase clearance over the existing vehicle access from Nutley Terrace.

Please see the accompanying plan for tree locations, tree data and a photograph of each tree Ref: CCL 11002 - V2 Site Plan.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
