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We object to the planning proposal.

Fundamentally, we object to any large scale building of dwelling houses in London. London dominates all other cities in the UK. There is a demand for housing in London, due to permission given to construct large scale office blocks, and many seek employment in such office blocks. It damages the environment for the many who live in and work in London.

Regarding the details of the proposal, we note that a principally commercial area would be replaced with a large area of high density housing. The present commercial area serves a need of the existing city, is of low profile and is of low density. If the present commercial area is replaced with housing, other areas will have to be developed to provide what the present area provides.

Regarding the details of the proposal, the area itself would be damaged by the large number of very high blocks and the great increase of motor traffic in the area, with no benefit to those living in this or any part of London, and in this part of London, there would be a significant increase in pollution. There would be more street crime. For those living in this part of London, the construction of so many tower blocks would significantly impair the view from the top of Parliament Hill, a popular viewing platform.

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
