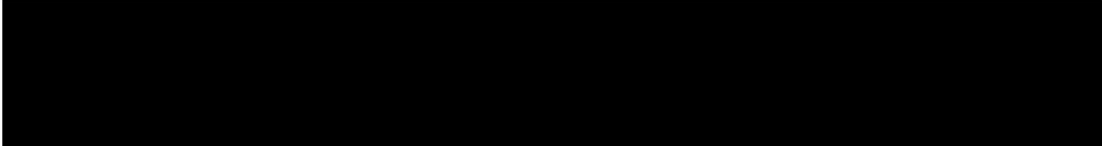

To whom it may concern:

I want to lodge my objections to the current planning application number 2021/3225/P for Murphy's Yard. The planning application details plans for massive overdevelopment of the site with tower structures that damage the skyline of a vital element of refuge to many of us in the vicinity, Hampstead Heath. The view from Parliament Hill which features a map of the London skyline would be blighted by towers that block light and detract from important open views and space. It also seems that the number of planned residential units doesn't stipulate any agreed percentage of affordable housing nor is there adequate provision of public green space for prospective residents of the proposed development. This is unacceptable as residents will need safe places to sit and for their children to play close to their flats. My other objection is about the proposed corridor between the proposed development and the Gospel Oak station which doesn't appear to be thought through in terms of plantings, drainage, design, and sustainability. The entire proposal appears to favour over-development and cramming lots of people into a space that will ultimately be destructive to the local environment, views, light, and crowd the existing local amenities and adjacent areas. It defies conservation and is detrimental in its density and scope.
