Dear Sirs

The planning application to the felling of the two trees in the yard of 8 Doughty Street has been revived. This is regrettable due to many previous submissions made opposing this type of activity for very cogent reasons.

It is also evident that the Egyptian Company has not explored sufficient options to the felling of the trees to prevent the alleged damage to their property. There are other options, albeit at an expense.

On balance, it is worth opposing this current planning application due to the environmental and structural impact and the applicants incur the expense. Some of these are:

- The risk of flooding in the area;
- Decline in the life quality of people as the trees create oxygen and absorb the greenhouse gases.
- The impact on the wildlife
- Soil erosion.
