As a long-time resident near the Heath, I write to object in the strongest terms to the disgraceful proposal to erect six tower blocks from 11 to 19 storeys high site on the south side of Gordon House Road, so closely adjacent to Parliament Hill Fields and the entrance to Hampstead Heath.

It is now generally agreed that high-rise housing has no advantage at all over low-rise housing. To build high tower blocks in such close proximity to the Heath is against all the planning commitments regarding the preservation of the fringes of the Heath.

It is also a foolish proposal to introduce a large additional population at a point where public services such as education and transport and medical services are already overborne.

This application must be rejected.
