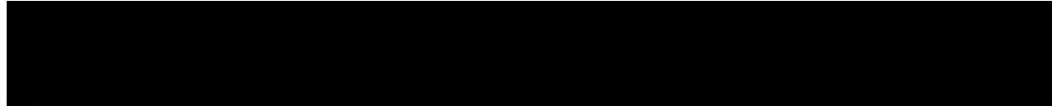

Dear Sir.

I wish to object to the above Application. My reasons are as follows:

1. Mass, density and great height of proposed buildings. This will seriously interrupt and spoil views from the Heath, especially from Parliament Hill which is such a popular and important viewing position.
2. Great density of development and lack of green space for the huge number of people who will be living and working there. This will mean that crowds of them will naturally flow onto the Heath and thus overcrowd the area, particularly again, Parliament Hill, causing inevitable degradation.
3. Generally the peace and wild countryside character of the Heath, at present so important to Londoners will be very much compromised by such an excessively overdense Development
