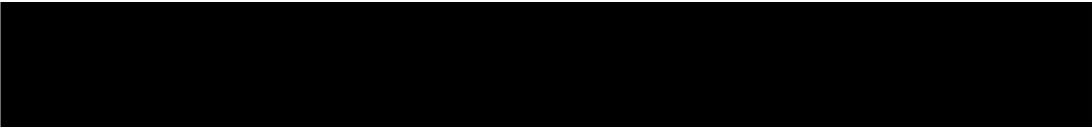

We are writing in regard to the above planning application (Murphy's Yard) and we object on several fronts.

1. The development of this site in its present form would set a totally unacceptable precedent for the building of high-rise blocks on the edge of the Heath. The height, mass and density of this proposal would impact in several ways as follows:-

- a) It would be absolutely out of character with the surrounding area
- b) It would impact on the openness of the Heath from the Lido and surrounding playing fields
- c) It would block the light of a number of neighbouring residents
- d) It would impact on the capacity of local services to deal with the environmental issues of noise and traffic
- e) It would cause a loss of view, very specifically from the plaque, at the top of Parliament Hill

2. The development does not provide for any true green and open spaces. As a result:-

- a) The residents themselves will not be afforded any necessary green space on their immediate doorstep
- b) The residents, as a result, will understandably resort to accessing the Heath which will overwhelm the Heath

We, therefore, urge that the application for this development is rejected.
