Hello.

I am writing please to object to the current Murphy yard plans for development in Gospel Oak/Kentish Town.

Many of the buildings look interesting but some proposed buildings seem to be soulless monsters.

The proposed plans are lacking affordable homes, in the appropriate number of rooms in each property, lacking welcoming out-door space green areas/corridors and will negatively effect area road traffic, increase stress levels on local infrastructure, negatively influence the sun light on the neighbourhood and views from the park that are enjoyed by so so many.
