Summary

The proposed development of the Murphy's Yard site to a height of up to 19 storeys would affect the strategic views of central London from Parliament Hill, which are of major importance. The impact would be significant, blocking, and diminishing the impact of, views of key parts of central London from a number of angles on Parliament Hill. Regional and local policies both strongly support the importance of these strategic views. Historic England has significant concerns about the harmful impact of the proposals, and these should be addressed.
