Dear Sir/Madam,

I wish to object to this application to reduce the height of this tree by as much as 6m. This would be an act of pure vandalism for a tree protected by a TPO in a Conservation Area, that is (as an approximation from the single photo provided) only some 8m tall in total.

Reducing the height of a mature tree such as this one by as much as 75% is likely to be very prejudicial to its health and will likely kill it. No justification is given for such drastic pollarding and it appears to be in good health, and not allegedly causing any structural issue.

As it is subject to a TPO and is in a Conservation Area in a very visible front garden location, please can you permit only a much more modest crown reduction and no more than a 20% reduction in height?
