I have no objection to the maintenance work being carried out on these three trees, especially those to previous points. I understand that previously work was carried out on the Dartmouth Park Road side of the Copper Beech (T3), so this work will balance the crown.

## 2022/0593/T. 33 Dartmouth Park Avenue

As stated previously, the Plum is not well shaped and re-planting with another Plum could lead to replant disease. Therefore No Objection. However pruning work to the Magnolia could produce a well-shaped tree.

## 2022/0645/T. 6, St Anne's Close

I met with the applicant Kate Tyndall.

I have no objection to the tree works, she explained that reshaping the Hawthorn and Laurel, and the planting of bushes with spines adjacent to them, will hopefully deter anti-social behaviour in the future.
