Firstly, the house itself will not link normally with neighbours in the terrace - the result is bedrooms in one property next to living rooms in its neighbour and so on which seems bound to cause noise problems in these poorly sound-insulated houses. Secondly, the introduction of three units in place of one must put pressure on the environment with three sets of cars, bins etc. in place of one.</p> <p>Of course, such developments are not without precedent - In my opinion, the precedents in this street perfectly illustrate the force of the objection to trying to squeeze three units out of a core building only designed for one unit.</p>
