This restaurant has a sorry history of violating regulations to the detriment of their neighbors, and these proposed tables, chairs, and barriers are going to make an already crowded passageway impassable. We all want to see the neighborhood thrive commercially, but it is time for the Council to tilt the balance back away from total appeasement of commercial interests, towards greater consideration of the residents, and the general quality of life for the neighborhood, both for visitors and for the people who live here.
