Dear Tony,

The DPCAAC had been waiting to see the additional information that you had requested from the applicant.

This information has not been received and the DPCAAC would support the view of the Grove Terrace Association that the applicant has not submitted sufficient information to allow a full evaluation of the application. There is no evidence that that a sim card facility is needed at this location. It would be wholly dependent on local school children and could be a target for vandalism. In any event, there are a many shops selling sim cards a short walk away.

Maintenance of this Grade II structure in a Conservation Area and directly opposite the Grade II Grove Terrace would be very important.

It is acknowledged that the consultation period for this Listed consent application has ended but the information provided is clearly inadequate as you had indicated and the DPCAAC view is that this application should be rejected
