Subject: Dying tree.

Good morning Rav: Sorry to trouble you but I wanted your guidance on what is required with respect to a damaged and dying tree in my garden that I would like to remove and replace with a healthy new specimen tree.

The tree in question suffered a break at the top roughly 10 or so years ago and the tree surgeon at the time lopped off the top where the trunk had broken. The tree has survived but is in a very poor state with extensive dead branches and one side already dead. While the tree is not at risk of immediately falling over, it is clearly severely damaged and is slowly dying. It would not be possible to repair or revive the tree.

My current tree surgeon has recommended the tree be removed and replaced with a new specimen.

Can you please let me know what I need to do?
