Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 2 x Acers (T1 & T2) - Prune by 3m - 3.5m to reduce the canopy size.  
1 x Eucalyptus (T3) - Fell to ground level and grind out stump.  
1 x Himalayan Birch (Betula Utilis) (T4) - Prune by 3.5m - 5m to reduce size  
1 x Yew (Taxus Baccata) (T5) - Prune by 1.5m - 2m to reduce size.  
1 x Atlas Cedar (Cedrus Atlantica) (T6) - Fell to ground level.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 11 February 2022 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 2 Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife. Of particular note is the protection offered to bats, birds and their nests from construction works. For
