We are an art gallery and venue occupying a Grade 2 Listed former Victorian school building in Bloomsbury, Camden Council, London. Our property comprises an outdoor, internal courtyard with a metal staircase that provides access to the first and second floors. We would like to install a stairlift on the staircase to improve access for people with compromised mobility. The stairlift would require no permanant modifications to the building and would be fully removeable. As there is no lift in the building, and no other starilift, the proposal would help to address a current lack of Accessible access to the upper floors.

The first floor of the building comprises ten accomodation rooms for long and short term lets and the second floor of the building comprises two large rooms offered for hire for a variety of uses including film shoots, meetings, classes, workshops, performances, rehearsals and screenings.
