				Being constructed from plastic composite and aluminium, it will not weather or blend into the environment. It will remain looking like plastic for years to come.
				The fence is higher than the planning application elevations. From the top of the existing brick wall to the top of the fence it is 1830mm, not 1600mm as in the planning application. The upright joists between the plastic panels are even taller.
				To have replaced a wooden fence with a huge, solid, plastic fence is not considerate to the history or aesthetics of the garden's location - nothing will ever grow between or around it.
				As it overlooks the Heath and the East Heath Road, the ideal material is wood. It should not be higher than the previous fence/trellis. I would suggest that the fence is replaced like for like, and the wood reinstated.
