"Overall, it is considered the construction of a side terrace and associated walkway is unacceptable in principle for design and amenity reasons. It is considered that the proposed terrace and walkway would harm the character and appearance of the host dwelling and the conservation area and should be omitted, if a future planning application was submitted. Expanding the existing driveway, is considered unacceptable due to the loss of front boundary wall and increasing hardstanding area and should also be omitted from any future planning application. The proposed rooflights at roof level and at lower ground floor level should be reduced in size ensuring it is a modest addition. Other works are considered acceptable subject to further clarifications on the detailed design. In addition any future planning application should include clear and detailed plans with annotations."
