The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** advertisement consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

- The proposed advertisement, by virtue of its location, scale, prominence, method of illumination, resulting in a sequential series of static digital images due to proximity to an existing kiosk would add visual clutter and contribute to an over proliferation of illuminated signage, detrimental to the amenity of the streetscene and the setting of adjacent Camden Town Conservation Area, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D4 (Advertisements) of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
- 2 The proposed advertisement, by virtue of its location, scale, prominence, and

method of illumination, would introduce a distraction to traffic and pedestrians, causing harm to highway and public safety, contrary to Transport for London guidance, and to Policies A1 (Managing the Impact of Development), D4 (Advertisements) and T1 (Prioritising walking, cycling and public transport) of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
