This proposal is out of keeping with the overall look and nature of Hillfield Court (HC), which is an Art Deco building constructed in 1934, and would be aesthetically very displeasing. Further, its construction would entail interference with the balcony which is part of the building's fabric and which has not been demised to the applicant. Both care and especially resource are expended by the HC management in maintaining the period look and feel of HC, as far as this is commensurate with the demands and needs of modern living.
