I object to any trees being reduced or removed that would impact on my views. Any changes to trees that are on the side that backs on to the garden of 29 Hampstead Lane N6. This would significantly impact to me as I am on the first floor flat, which is higher up and my windows look directly in this direction of this house and garden.

My beautiful green trees views have been effected only last week as a summer house has been agreed and erected, at the bottom of the garden to No. 25 Hampstead Lane (which backs onto Summit House) and the wall and trees behind the Summer house have been removed resulting in that now I am seeing right into the house named (Summit Fitzroy Park N6 6HS).
