I'm writing regarding application reference: 2022/1187/T.

As a Delancey St resident I strongly oppose the proposition to remove two trees from a listed conservation area. This would severely impact the biodiversity and air quality in the area, alongside the green oasis we are lucky enough to have a view of at the back of our garden-less flat.

Pruning would be a much preferable option, to fell the two trees would be shortsighted and against all your 'green credentials' - actively counteracting your policy of planting 400 trees in the area per annum. Sycamore and Ash only make up 3 and 4% respectively of all the trees in Camden.

Please reconsider the options without cutting down these two trees.
