Dear Sirs, I live at 24 Delancey Street and look out onto the back gardens area within which these two trees are situated. I strongly object to the felling of the two trees as described in the planning application above.

Their removal will have a negative effect on the visual appearance of the whole rear gardens area which at present is generous in trees and of great benefit to the existing wild life especially native birds.

It is difficult to understand why these trees would need to be cut down. If it is an insurance request then this should be tested by a qualified arboraculturalist. In my experience insurance companies are often over cautious. These trees could be pollarded if the canopies are encouraging the spread of the root protection area.
