Dear Laura Dorbeck,

I would like to object to the planning application from Lab Tech to extend the hours of the Hawley Wharf development. Any extension of hours would bring an increase in night-time activity, which is already a problem in Chalk Farm and Camden Town because of the proliferation of alcohol licences in the area. I understand that Hawley Wharf's hours were originally limited in order to protect the amenities of the surrounding area, and so any change will naturally damage these amenities - which are already affected by the night-time activity.

I am surprised that the applicants think that extending the hours will increase footfall. It seems to me, and to my neighbours, that a radical change is needed in the market to attract more visitors. The content, layout and signposting need attention.

I hope the Committee will reject this application.
