The current proposal proposes the removal of a significant number of trees (all but one of the existing trees in the property), with few being replaced. In addition, the proposal does not detail the type of replacement tree(s) to be planted, which appear nevertheless significantly smaller</p> <p>In the current environment of climate change and increased flooding risk, this is specially worrying as it decreases CO2 retention, can increase water runs and flooding risks, while also reducing significantly the canopy cover in the neighbourhood, already significantly reduced by recent tree removals.</p>
